Seventh International Energy Week – “Global Energy” International Award Summit

The International Energy Week - “Global Energy” International Award Summit was hosted by Moscow on October 25-26, 2012.

The laureates of “Global Energy” awards, representatives of the International Partnership on energy efficiency cooperation, the Russian-German energy agency, the Russian-Dutch center of energy efficiency, government authorities from 37 countries have participated in the work of the Forum as guests of honor.
